— QUIZZING —

RACE TO THE QUOTE

Players needed: 3-10

Object of the game:

Be the first team to score 10 points. Score a point by being the first one to quote the verse!

Items needed:

Quiz book

60-second timer

Setup:

Pick one player to be the verse reader. This person will moderate the game by giving the randomized verse, following along to make sure the verse is quoted correctly within 60 seconds, and awarding the allotted points.

Have everyone divide up into two teams. Each team should pick a team name.

Game Play:

The verse reader will pick a random verse from the quiz book, for example:

“Acts 1:14 Quote”

Each player races to be the first one to say the **FIRST** word of the verse correctly. The player who is quickest to say the first word, (e.g., “**All**”) will then “win” the verse.

The quiz reader points to the player who says the word first, and they are allotted 60 seconds to quote the whole verse.

*“**All** these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers.” Acts 1:14*

If the verse is quoted correctly one point is awarded to the team. If the verse is quoted incorrectly no point is awarded and the next verse is read.

If there is a tie, (i.e., both players say "**All**" simultaneously) the verse goes into free play, and the person who quotes the **entire** verse first wins.

Team Effort

If a player says the first word but cannot think of the rest of the verse they may "pass" the quote to another player on their team. *Each player* is allowed to do this **once** per round. There are two rounds in a game.

Winning The Game

The first team to score 10 points wins the round. The first team to win 2 rounds wins the game!
